Greetings in the Precious Name of Jesus Christ

The LORD has outlined several projects for *Ministry Architecture, Inc.* for May 2011.

JERICHO

It all started last fall when Mary Jo was thinking about Jericho being the Judea and Samaria where Jesus told us to go and be witnesses. (Acts 1:8). We had the thought that the LORD was going to take us to the West Bank. Could this really be true?

Then Tass Sada asked Len to design a community Sports Complex in Jericho!

Tass is the author of *Once an Arafat Man*. He used to be a Palestinian sniper, was known as "the butcher", and was the personal driver for Yassar Arafat -- until Jesus miraculously saved him. His life has become another visible miracle of God Who can transform the meanest soul!

Tass plans to use the Sports Complex for social needs for young people, conferences, and meetings. It will include a soccer field and large indoor pool.

So we're going to work in Jericho from May 8 to 10 as witnesses to Judea and Samaria.

NEGEV DESERT

Then from May 10- 13 we're going to the Negev Desert, to Arad.

Obadiah verse 20 speaks of a prophecy of Spanish-speaking Jews returning to Israel and populating the Negev. The Cyrus Foundation in Ft. Collins has been helping Latin Jews move from South America to The Land -- to integrate them -- thus helping to fulfill this prophecy.

Now *Ministry Architecture, Inc.* is also a part of this fulfillment as Len has been asked to design the housing these families God has chosen for Aliyah "ascent" - the immigration of Jews to the Land of Israel (Eretz Yisrael).

A pilot program for future housing is being developed with community officials.
