
MOSCOW, RUSSIA

Our assignment inside Russia is complete. We just returned with gladness for what the Lord has done. Thank you for praying during the days and nights while we met with God's people. ***"...we know and rely on the love God has for us [and them]..."*** (1 John 4:16)

Our purpose was to present an important message:

The Ezekiel Option, which illustrates the prophecies and compels attention to Scriptures, has been translated into the Russian language and is now available to Russian leaders at NO COST.

We also taught *"...prepare and get ready..."* (Ezekiel 38:7) because the prophecies of Ezekiel are certain to come and they include the people of Russia and Israel.



During eight days we had intensive personal meetings and met with Russian Christian leaders: pastors, bishops, missionaries, and congregations. They told us of their powerful experiences with the love of Jesus Christ:



- ✓ ***Miraculous revelations to lost souls***
- ✓ ***Evangelical outreaches to troubled youth***
- ✓ ***Seeking of Christ by intellectuals***
- ✓ ***Eagerness to learn the Truth that sets us free***

Leadership response to the book was very good. They want their ministry colleagues to read *The Ezekiel Option* and consider using the book for evangelism, to edify the saints, and lead them deeper into scripture.

■ ***One evening...***we attended a service in a carefully chosen location. Scientists and intellectuals listened intently to teaching from Ezekiel and learned of God's will "...they shall know that I am the Lord" (Ezekiel 38:23).

■ ***On two mornings...***we went to groups in nondescript places to teach from the Bible.


■ ***On some afternoons...***we preached and taught in obscure parts of the city.



■ ***One night...***we walked past dumpsters and down stairs to a dim basement. There we entered a Christian radio station—right there in Moscow!

Testimonies, prayer, and encouragement are put into the airwaves of the city once called by President Reagan "the evil empire". For two

hours we were interviewed, told our testimonies, and answered live call-in questions.



Mary summarized our visits with these words:

“It is still dangerous to be a follower of Jesus in Russia. Many people are careful of what they talk about on the phone. Some congregations are forced to move. On the other hand, we visited a 3,000 member congregation that has been meeting for many years in a three story former cinema with an all glass front. It is only explained by Winston Churchill who called Russia ‘a riddle wrapped in a mystery inside an enigma’. That is all true, but I loved being there!”
